RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Silver Lake.

Fishing in Silver Lake regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be and hereby is directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Silver Lake in the town of Bucksport, in the county of Hancock, to ice fishing for all fish except game fish, from the time the ice forms in the fall until the 1st day of March following; also opening said lake to ice fishing for game fish during February of each year under the general law.
