STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Licensing of Aircraft.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Unrestricted license for home-built aircraft. A special unrestricted experimental license shall issue to the operator of any home-built aircraft answering to the conditions hereinafter imposed.

Sec. 2. License conditioned; requirements. Said license shall issue only, upon compliance with the following provisions:

- (1) The craft shall have no more than 50 horse power.
- (2) It must bear a department of commerce identification number.
- (3) Its pilot must have had at least 10 hours dual control to his credit.
- (4) It must seat a pilot only.
- (5) It shall not be rented, nor carry material of any kind for hire.
