RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Mousam Lake Tributaries.

Fishing in Mousam Lake Tributaries regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to fishing under the general law, the tributaries, wherever situated, to Mousam Lake; said pond being in the towns of Acton and Shapleigh.
