**RESOLVE, Regulating Smelt Fishing in Swan Lake.**

---

**Smelt fishing in Swan Lake regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the waters of Swan Lake, in the towns of Swanville, Frankfort and Searsport to ice fishing for smelts from the time that the ice forms in the fall until the 1st day of April, following; also opening the waters of said lake to the taking of smelts for bait purposes, under the general law.
