STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to State Highway Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Title of "state highway police." The "state highway police" are hereby designated and shall hereafter be known as the 'state police.'

Sec. 2. Amendatory clause. Wherever in the statutes or laws of the state of Maine the words "state highway police" appear, or the words "member of the state highway police" appear, they shall be held to mean 'state police' and 'member of the state police,' respectively.
