**AN ACT Providing for the Manufacture of Motor Vehicle Registration
Plates and Other Plates for the Use of the State at the State Prison.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Motor vehicle plates to be manufactured at state prison. The secretary of state or the duly designated official in charge of motor vehicle registration shall, when this act becomes law, purchase and cause to be installed at the state prison the necessary equipment and materials for the production of all motor vehicle registration plates used in the state. He shall also, from time to time, if upon reasonable investigation finds it expedient, procure such additional equipment and materials as may be necessary for the production of all road markers, signs and posters and any such other plates as may be needed by the state; and thereafter no such plates shall be purchased for state use except such as cannot be produced at the prison, but no plates shall be manufactured at the prison for purposes other than state use.

Sec. 2. Warden of the prison to have full charge of production; may employ temporary supervisor. The warden of the state prison shall have full charge of operations at the state prison relative to the manufacture

of all plates made for the state. He may, with the consent of the secretary of state or the head of any department for which plates may hereafter be made, employ for limited periods of time a supervisor for the purpose of instructing inmates in the operation of making such plates, signs or posters.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act, the secretary of state may expend such sum or sums as in his judgment may be necessary, and said funds are hereby appropriated, same to be obtained from the general highway fund.
