STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Town and County Officers Enforcing Laws Along the Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Limitation of powers of certain police officers. No town or county police officer shall enforce any law of the state of Maine along any of the highways in said state unless he be in uniform or otherwise bearing conspicuous evidence of his authority.
