STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Permitting Agricultural Societies to Conduct Exhibitions on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Agricultural societies may conduct their exhibitions on Sunday. Agricultural societies, incorporated under the laws of this state, may conduct their fairs on Sunday and charge the usual admission thereto provided the municipal officers of the town or city in which the same is conducted, gives a permit therefor in writing.
