# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to the Practice of Optometry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 21, § 49, amended. Section 49 of chapter 21 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 49. Unlawful to practice unless registered; exceptions. No person shall practice optometry in this state, unless he shall first obtain a certificate of registration from the state board of registration and examination in optometry, and file the same with the clerk of the superior court of the county in which he proposes to practice, as hereinafter provided; but sections 47 to 59, both inclusive, shall not apply to persons authorized under the laws of this state to practice medicine within the state of Maine, nor to resident merchants so long as they shall sell spectacles, only, that do not contain opthalmic lenses.'
