RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Greeley Pond.

Fishing in Greeley pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Greeley pond in Readfield and Mount Vernon, county of Kennebec, to ice fishing for all fish except game fish, from the time that the ice forms in the fall until the 1st day of April following, also open for game fish during February and March under the general law.
