IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, For the Purchase of Salmon from the Weir Fishermen on Penobscot River.

Purchase of salmon; warden patrol. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$2000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1936, and \$2000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1937, for the purchase of salmon from the weir fisherman on the Penobscot river and for the employment of a warden to patrol said river, to keep the fishways free from refuse and to perform such other work as may be needed.
