# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

## AN ACT Relating to Printing in Town Reports Names of Persons Receiving Relief.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 5, §63, amended.** The first sentence of section 63 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Persons charged with the expenditure of the money of a town, shall, on or before the morning of each annual meeting, make a full, detailed written or printed report of all their financial transactions in behalf of the town during the municipal year immediately preceding, with a full account of the receipts and disbursements during that period, and to whom and for what purpose each item of the same was paid, **except that the names of persons receiving relief need not be provided** with a statement in detail of the indebtedness and resources of the town; including a list of all unpaid taxes which have been committed to the treasurer or collector for collection, giving the names of all delinquent taxpayers and the amount due from each.'
