AN ACT Relating to Expenses of County Attorneys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 38, amended. The last paragraph of section 38 of chapter 125, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'York, \$1600, and no other fees, costs, or emoluments, **except actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties**, shall be allowed them. The assistant county attorney for the county of Androscoggin, \$1000. The assistant county attorney for the county of Cumberland, \$1800.'
