IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Prisoners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Compensation for prisoners working in state prison. Any person imprisoned in the state prison, who, by reason of good conduct and upon the recommendation of the warden shall receive as compensation for services performed by him, a sum not exceeding 15 cents per diem during the term of his imprisonment. Such sum shall be deposited to his credit and shall be paid by the warden to such convict upon his discharge from said prison: **Provided,** the warden may, during the term of such imprisonment, pay to such person or to his wife, parent or parents, or children, such portion of such compensation as may, in his opinion, be necessary for the welfare of such convict, his wife, parent or parents, or children.

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
