**RESOLVE in Favor of the Maine Guide's Association.**

---

**Appropriation for advertising Maine guides. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the use of the Maine guide's association, from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, received from the sale of class "A" guides licenses, the sum of \$1 for each class "A" license sold, for the purpose of advertising Maine guides, and stimulating interest in the recreational advantages of the state of Maine, if in the judgment of the commissioner of inland fisheries and game such advertising would be advantageous; otherwise said funds shall revert to the general funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.
