AN ACT Relating to Exemptions.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 13, § 6, ¶ IV, amended.** Paragraph IV of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘IV. The household furniture of each person, not exceeding \$500 to any one family, his wearing apparel, farming utensils, mechanics’ tools necessary for his business, **radium**, and musical instruments not exceeding in value \$50 to one family.’
