STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Licensing the Operation of Certain Machines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. License for operating vending machines. No person, firm, association or corporation shall have in his possession any of the machines, equipment or appliances, hereinafter mentioned without having first received from the secretary of state a license so to possess the same, after application therefor, in writing.

Sec. 2. Fees. The annual fees for the licensing of each of the following machines, equipment or appliances, shall be in accordance with the following schedule and shall accompany the application for license, to wit

Pin game, coin operated	\$10.00
Musical instrument, coin operated	10.00
Cigarette vending machine with 6 columns therein	7.00
Cigarette vending machine with 4 columns therein	5.00
Candy vending machine which costs 5c to operate	5.00
Candy vending machine which costs 1c to operate	3.00
Peanut vending machine	5.00
Gum vending machine which costs 1c to operate	3.00
Amusement machinery arcade equipment	10.00

Sec. 3. License. The secretary of state upon the receipt of any such application for license or licenses, accompanied by the required fee or fees, shall issue a license or licenses to the applicant.

Sec. 4. Exhibition of license. Said license when issued shall be exhibited on each machine or equipment.

Sec. 5. Penalty. Any person, firm, association, or corporation having in his possession any of said machines, equipment or appliances, without a license attached thereto, shall be punished by a fine of \$25.
