STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Allocation of Funds Derived from a State Lottery.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Allocation of funds. In the event that a state lottery is established under the laws of Maine the net amount received by the state under such act shall be allocated, appropriated, and used as follows:

- (a) 20% thereof for the administration of said lottery; if any part thereof is not needed for such purpose, such part shall be applied to the purpose mentioned in subsection (c) hereof:
- (b) 40% thereof for prizes to be awarded in the conduct of said state lottery;
- (c) 40% thereof to the hospitals and charitable institutions in Maine, for the maintenance of which appropriations have been made by the legislature in the past; each hospital and charitable institution to receive such proportion of the amount herein allocated to them as a loss as the total amount received by it during the last 10 years bears to the amount herein allocated to them as a class.
