**AN ACT Relating to Defrauding Rooming Home Owners.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 36, § 17, amended.** Section 17 of chapter 30 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 17. Penalty for fraud in obtaining food, etc.** Whoever obtains food, lodging or other accommodations at any hotel, inn, boarding-house, **rooming house**, or eating house, with intent to defraud the owner or keeper thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100, or by imprisonment for not more than 3 months.'
