IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Trial Terms in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 91, § 21; relating to trial terms, further amended. The last paragraph of section 21 of chapter 91 of the revised statutes, as amended, in so far as it relates to York county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'York: At ~~Alfred~~ **Saco** on the second Tuesday of January and at **Alfred on the** first Tuesdays of May and October.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 92, § 5; relating to regular sessions, further amended. The last paragraph of section 5 of chapter 92 of the revised statutes, as amended in so far as it relates to York county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'York, terms of record on the first Tuesday of April and October at Alfred, and regular sessions shall be held on the first Tuesday of each month, at ~~Alfred~~ **Saco in February, and at Alfred in all other months.'**
