STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relative to Non-Resident License for Hunting Raccoons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 41, amended. The last sentence of sub-paragraph (3) of section 41 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The license to hunt wild birds, rabbits, raceoons, foxes and unprotected wild birds or wild animals only shall be issued on payment of \$5.15, and to hunt both wild birds and wild animals on payment of \$15.15 of which 15 cents shall be retained by the agent issuing the license.'
