AN ACT Relative to the Suspension of Bounties on Porcupines and Hedgehogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38, § 78, suspended. The provisions of section 78 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, relating to the bounties on porcupines and hedgehogs, are hereby suspended until June 30, 1937.

Sec. 2. P. L., 1931, c. 249, suspended. The provisions of chapter 249 of the public laws of 1931, relating to payment of bounties on porcupines, are hereby suspended until June 30, 1937.
