STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relative to the Repeal of Bounties on Porcupines and Hedgehogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38, § 78, repealed. The provisions of section 78 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, relating to the bounties on porcupines and hedgehogs, are hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. P. L., 1931, c. 249, repealed. The provisions of chapter 249 of the public laws of 1931, relating to payment of bounties on porcupines, are hereby repealed.
