STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Employment by the State of Maine of Pensioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Employment of pensioners by the state. No person, who is in receipt of any pension, either in the form of compensation, federal, state or city, shall be employed in the state, in any capacity by the state, city or town, or local government, while being paid any pension.

Sec. 2. Employment of married women. No married woman shall be employed by the state, city or town whose husband is engaged in any employment for which he is paid a compensation or is engaged in business in his own behalf.
