STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to County Attorneys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 93, § 15, amended. The first sentence of section 15 of chapter 93 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘County attorneys shall be elected and notified, their elections determined and vacancies filled in the same manner, and they shall enter upon the discharge of their duties at the same time as is provided respecting county commissioners, but they shall hold office for ~~two~~ 4 years.’
