STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Avoid Contracts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- **Sec. 1. Contracts voidable.** Any contract, or part thereof printed or mimeograph in less than 8 point type, shall be voidable at the option of either party thereto.
- Sec. 2. Not applicable to stock certificates. The foregoing provision shall not apply to certificates of stock, bonds, or bond coupons, uniform bills of lading or other documents which comply with the laws of this or of any other state dealing with attempts at uniformity.
