STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Public Utilities Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Authority of the commission. The 5th sentence of section 1 of chapter 62 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Under the direction of the governor and council The commission may hire the necessary help and expend such sums of money as may be necessary for the purchase of books, maps, stationery, office furniture, and supplies, for procuring statistics and information and for defraying expenses incidental to the discharge of its duties; it shall have sole authority to expend each year the appropriation made for its maintenance as it deems best.'

Sec. 2. Amendatory clause. All acts, or parts of acts, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended to conform to the provisions of this act.
