STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Authorizing The Dispensing of Medicinal Liquor on Prescription.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Druggists may dispense liquor on prescriptions. Any registered druggist is empowered and permitted to dispense medicinal liquors and alcohol of United States Pharmacopoeia Standard to any adult person on the presentation of a bona fide prescription signed by a reputable physician of this state. Records shall be kept of all such dispensations which shall be subject to inspection at all times by the state liquor commission.

Sec. 2. Penalty. Any druggist who violates the foregoing section shall be punished by a fine of \$100 and costs or by imprisonment for 30 days in jail or both such fine and imprisonment.
