## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Fixing the Rate of Wages of Employees on State and State Aid Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Rate of wages to be paid employees, on state and state aid highways. Employees upon state or state aid highways shall receive as wages a sum not less than 40 cents for each hour of labor, for a period of not exceeding 40 hours per week: for each hour of labor in excess of such 40 hours, the sum of 60 cents per hour shall be paid.

When construction or repairs of state or state aid roads is let under a contract to any contractor, a provision embodying the foregoing rate of wages and period of time constituting a week shall be incorporated therein.
