**RESOLVE, in Favor of An Educational Campaign to Lessen Accidents
Upon the Highways.**

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$15,000 to be expended under the direction of the secretary of state, to conduct a publicity campaign by means of radio broadcast, literature, newspaper advertising and other publicity methods calculated to lessen accidents upon the highways and to educate the public in the manner of safer and saner operation of motor vehicles upon the highways: the secretary of state hereby is authorized to receive contributions from private sources for the aforesaid purposes.
