STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Governor and Council to Acquire the Site of the Former Post Office in Portland from the Federal Government.

Acquisition of site. Resolved: That the governor and council, for and in behalf of the state, be and hereby are, authorized and directed to acquire from the United States the lot of land; and its appurtenances, situated on Exchange, Middle and Market streets in Portland which was the location of the former post office building, for uses of the state under such terms and conditions imposed by the government as they deem advisable; and be it hereby further

Appropriation. Resolved: That the sum of \$500 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be used in the acquisition of said land.
