# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Dealers in Securities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. L., 1931, c. 248, amended.** The 2nd sentence of chapter 248 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Such bond to be in an amount not exceeding ten thousand dollars, either with corporate or personal surety approved by the commissioner, for an individual who is a resident of this state and employs no salesman, shall be in the sum of \$5000; and for an individual, partnership or corporation, whether resident of the state or not, shall be in the amount of \$10,000.'
