STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Recordings of County Reports.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 67, amended. Section 67 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 67. Estimates to be recorded and transmitted to secretary of state. Said estimates shall be recorded by their clerk in a book; and a copy thereof shall be signed by the chairman of the county commissioners, and attested by their clerk, who shall transmit it to the office of the secretary of state on or before the 1st day of each January in which the legislature meets, together with the county reports for the 2 preceding years, to be by him laid before the legislature.'
