STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Everette Harriman, of Orland.

Everette Harriman reimbursed for damages. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$100, to be paid to Everette Harriman, of Orland, in full settlement of damage to his property, "said sum to be paid from the general highway funds, and the state highway commission is directed to make improvements so as to eliminate any damage to his spring water supply, also eliminate the water damage caused by new road construction to Mr. Harriman's residence."
