**RESOLVE, Relative to Fishing in Wentworth and Baker Ponds.**

---

**Fishing in Wentworth and Baker ponds, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation making it legal to fish for bass and white perch in Wentworth pond in Solon and Athens and Baker pond in Solon, from the time the ice goes out in the spring until September 30.
