**RESOLVE, in Favor of Grace R. Lee, of Augusta.**

---

**Grace R. Lee, of Augusta, compensated for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$33 to be paid to Grace R. Lee, of Augusta, in full settlement for damage to her automobile caused by a collision with a truck driven by a state employee, said sum to be paid from the military funds.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Grace Lee's car was going south on the airport road when an army truck, turning into the road from Western Avenue at a fast rate of speed, slewed on the icy surface and ran into the Lee's car, damaging it to the amount of \$33.
