#### RESOLVE, in Favor of Grace R. Lee, of Augusta.

Grace R. Lee, of Augusta, compensated for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$33 to be paid to Grace R. Lee, of Augusta, in full settlement for damage to her automobile caused by a collision with a truck driven by a state employee, said sum to be paid from the military funds.
