IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

**AN ACT to Prohibit the Dumping or Deposit of Refuse in the Waters of
Damariscotta River.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Deposit of refuse in Damariscotta river, regulated. No person shall cast, or deposit upon the shores of, or dump, release and deposit in, the waters of the Damariscotta river any refuse or rubbish, or otherwise pollute the waters of said river; except, however, that this chapter shall not apply to deposits from sewers. Whoever wilfully violates the provisions of this act or aids therein shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$100.
