RESOLVE, in Favor of O. L. Veague, of Castine.

O. L. Veague, reimbursed for damages. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$300 to reimburse O. L. Veague, of Castine, for damages to his property on account of the construction of a state highway, said sum to be paid from the general highway funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The highway passing Veague's house was raised to such a height that the level of his lot was far below the road and it was necessary to raise the house to the proper level at a big expense. Also the construction moved the ditch by the road on to the property of Mr. Veague.
