RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Greenlaw Brook.

Fishing in Greenlaw Brook regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation to close to fishing for a period from June 1st, 1935 to May 30th, 1939, Greenlaw Brook, so-called, which heads in T. 12; R. 7, and flows in a southeasterly direction through T. 11; R. 7 and T. 11; R. 6, emptying into what is known as Big Machias river.
