AN ACT Relating to Taking of White Fish in Mattawamkeag Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 38, § 28, relating to taking of white fish in Mattawamkeag lake, amended. Section 28 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended so that the last sentence thereof shall read as follows :

‘Except that gill nets of not larger than $1\frac{1}{4}$ inch mesh may be used in the taking of white fish in Eastern Grand lake and Hot Brook lake in Aroostook and Washington counties and in Baskahegan lake in Washington county, **and in Mattawamkeag lake in Aroostook county** during the month of November of each year.’
