STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Relative to Fishing in the River Between Mooselucmeguntic Lake and Upper Richardson Lake.

Fishing in river between Mooselucmeguntic Lake and Upper Richardson Lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Upper Dam pool and the river extending between Mooselucmeguntic lake and Upper Richardson lake to fishing from sunrise to I hour after sunset of each day.
