RESOLVE, Relating to Muskrats in Morrill Mill Pond.

Closed season on muskrats in Morrill Mill pond. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation declaring a closed season on muskrats in Morrill Mill pond in the county of Waldo for a period of 2 years.
