STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Members During Special Session of Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 10, ¶ 3, amended. The third paragraph of section 10 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'When an extra session is called by the governor, the members of the senate and house of representatives shall each be paid two dollars \$5 for every day's attendance, and mileage as aforesaid.'
