AN ACT Relating to Salary of Register of Deeds in Waldo County.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 125, § 44, amended.** Section 44 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended so that the 19th line of said section, pertaining to Waldo county, shall read as follows:

‘Waldo, ~~one thousand dollars~~ \$1400.’
