STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Repeal the Organization of the Plantation of Lang.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Lang plantation organization repealed; corporate existence survives for certain purposes. The organization of the plantation of Lang, pursuant to authority thereto conferred by chapter 123 of the private and special laws of 1895, is hereby repealed; provided, however, that the corporate existence, powers, duties, and liabilities of said plantation shall survive for the purpose of prosecuting and defending all pending suits and causes of suits to which said plantation is or may be a party, and all needful processes growing out of the same, and for the further purpose of providing for the payment of all or any judgments which may be rendered against said plantation and to pay state and county taxes for the year 1935.
