RESOLVE, Relative to opening Cold Brook and Toothaker Brook.

Fishing in Cold and Toothaker Brooks, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to fishing the mouth of Cold and Toothaker Brooks which are tributaries to Cupsuptic Lake up as far as the end of the deadwater at which point red posts may be placed. The open season for fishing on the area below said red posts shall correspond with the open season on Cupsuptic Lake.
