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**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in a Certain Lot of Land to Receiver of the State Trust Company.**

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**Forest commissioner authorized to convey state's interest in certain property. Resolved:** That the forest commissioner as land agent be, and hereby is, authorized to convey the interest of the state in an undivided  $\frac{1}{8}$  part of 15,744 acres, being Township No. 5, Range 7, W. K. R. in the county of Somerset, and of 655 acres reserved lands in said township, which was sold for taxes of the year 1931, together with the interest of the state in an undivided  $\frac{3}{8}$  part of the same premises, which was sold for taxes of the year 1932, to the receiver of the State Trust Company of Augusta, in his said capacity. in consideration of the payment, by said receiver, to the state, before August 1st, 1935, of the sum of \$589.16, with interest upon the sum of \$507.89 from February 1st 1935 to date of payment.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The land in question in this resolve was sold for taxes to the state. The time for redemption has expired and the purpose of this resolve is to allow the owners to redeem.
