### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Open for Fishing Three Brooks in the Town of Prentiss.

Fishing regulated in brooks in Prentiss. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to fishing under the general law Mud brook, Little Mud brook and Spruce brook, so-called, situated wholly or in part in the town of Prentiss.
