STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relative to the Salary of the Recorder of the Yorkshire Municipal
Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L., 1911, c. 279, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 279 of the private and special laws of 1911 is hereby amended to read, as follows :

'Sec. 15. Salary of judge. The judge shall receive a salary in full for all services of \$1000 per annum to be paid him by the county of York, and the recorder a salary of ~~three hundred dollars~~ \$500 per annum, payable quarterly.'
